- 1) From digital portraits taken during class time, correct your images using levels (value) and hue saturation (color) adjustment layers. Save your file as "your 3 initials" 2a.psd Example: MFW2a.psd
- 2) Using masks and blend modes, create a photo-realistic composite which incorporates aspects of at four to five other people's images in the class. Save your file as "your 3 initials" 2b.psd Example: MFW2b.psd
- 3) Create a 'patchwork composite', using a grid and choosing elements of different faces to compose a portrait. Experiment with filters, blend modes, color adjustments.

Save your file as "your 3 initials" 2c.psd Example: MFW2c.psd

Do not flatten or merge layers in your submitted files.

Use adjustment layers
Use masks
Use blend modes
Hand in 3 images: one color corrected portrait, and one composite, one patchwork composite
