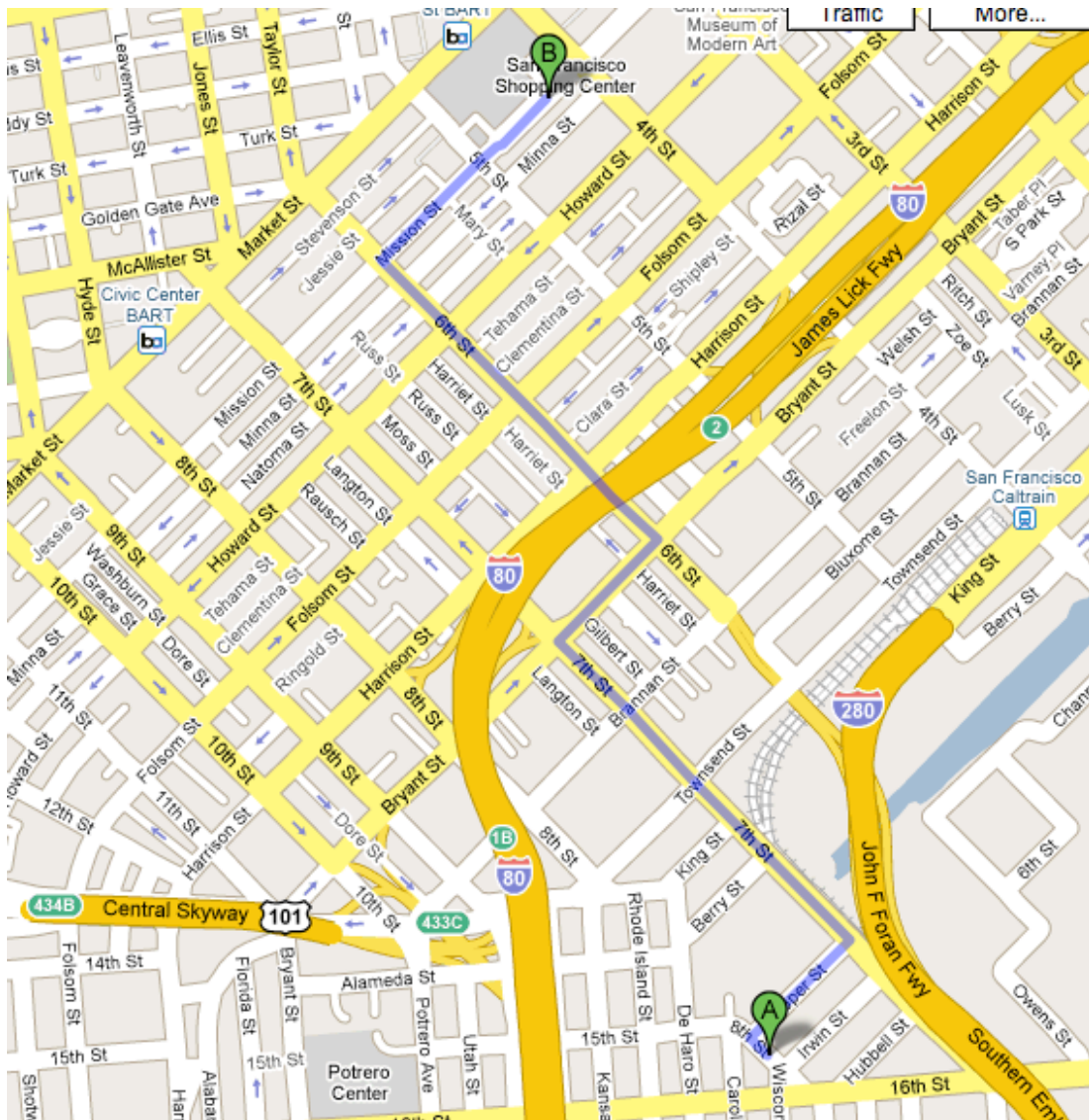

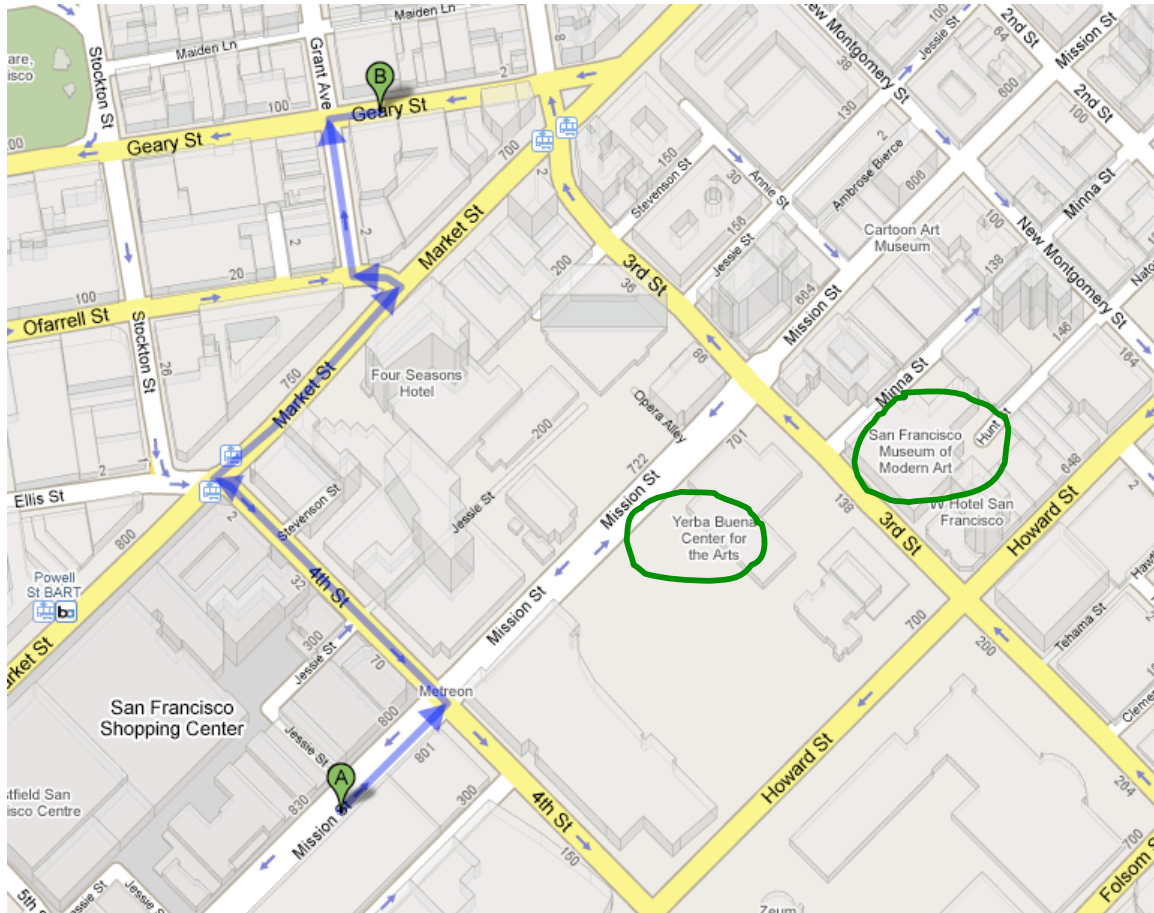

Exiting the city:

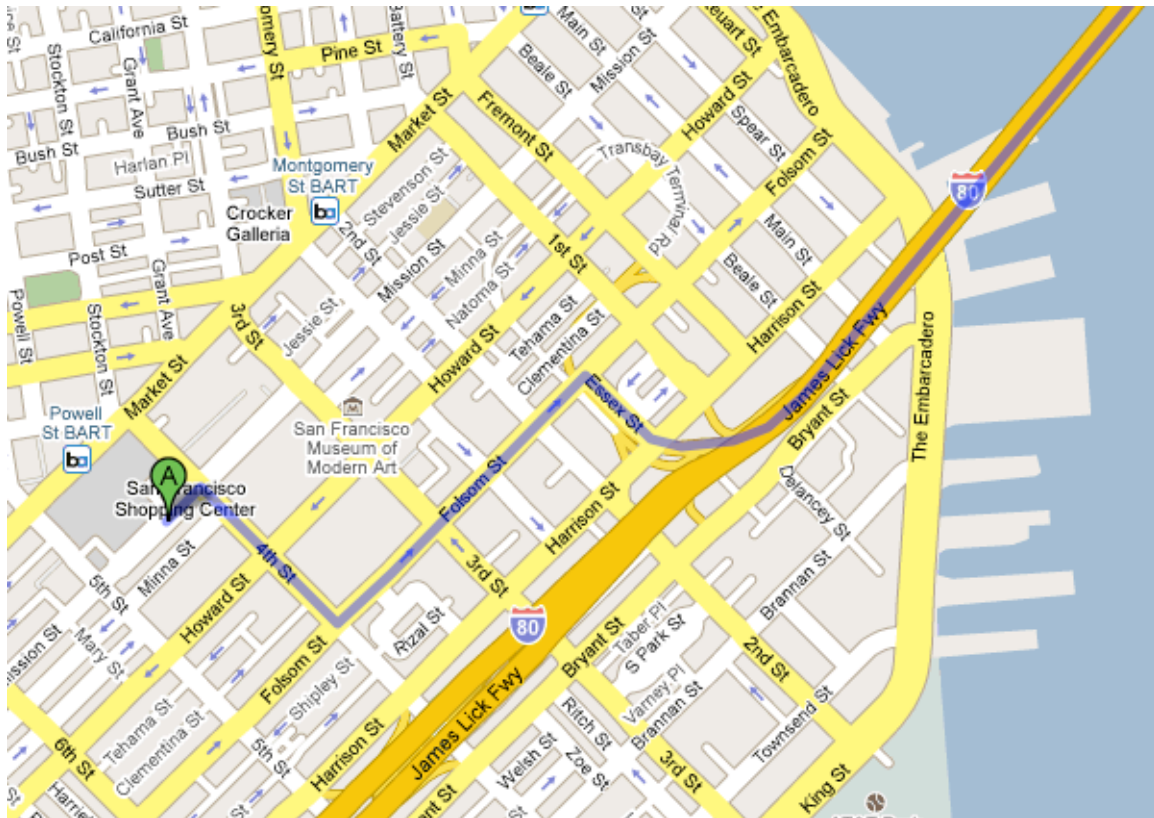
Head **northeast** on **Mission St** toward **4th St**
