

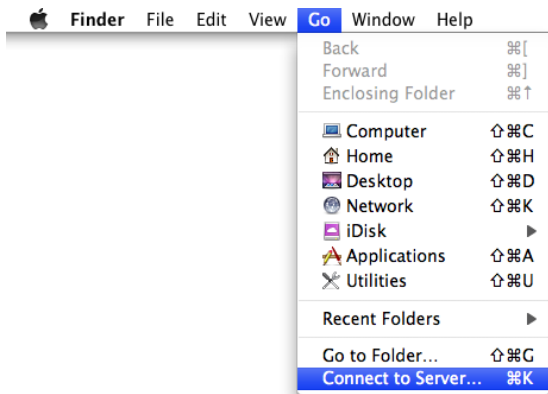

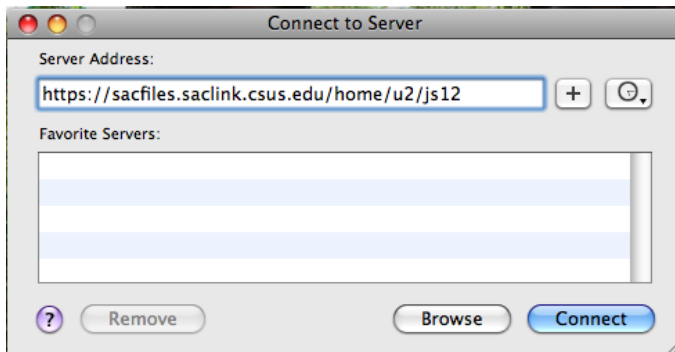

Create a connection to your Share Drive on Mac OS X

1. Go to Finder and select 'Go'. Scroll down and select 'Connect to Server...' from the menu bar.



2. In the 'Server Address' field enter <https://sacfiles.saclink.csus.edu/home/u#/username> with the [#] as the last character of your Saclink username if it is a digit. For example if the username was 'js12' then the character would be '2'. If your username does not end in a number then do not enter a number following the 'u'.



3. Click the '+' button to add to 'Favorite Servers'.
4. Click 'Connect' to connect to the share drive.
5. Enter your Saclink username in the 'Name' field and your Saclink password in the 'Password' field. Click 'OK'.



6. Your shared drive will appear on the left hand side of your finder window under 'Shared' when the connection is complete. You will see the contents of your personal drive in the finder window.
