



2017 Summer Undergraduate Research Experience (SURE) Awards

The College of Natural Sciences and Mathematics is pleased to announce that it has funding to continue to support projects in which faculty and **undergraduate** students work together on research or other scholarly projects during summer 2017.

Two forms of support are available to students:

- ❖ **Project Grants** will be available for up to \$500 for supplies, equipment, services and travel directly related to activities for approved research projects.
- ❖ **Stipends** of \$500 per week will be available for undergraduate students working on approved research projects full-time for 4-10 weeks during summer 2017. Students who receive the stipends can enroll in no more than one course and cannot have other employment while receiving the stipend.

Eligibility: Students must be undergraduates in the College of Natural Sciences and Mathematics. Faculty must be faculty in the College of Natural Sciences and Mathematics.

Submission of Applications: Application forms are found at the bottom of this document. Both students and their faculty mentor are required to submit application materials. Completed applications should be submitted to the Dean's Office no later than 5:00 pm on **Wednesday, March 15, 2017. No late entries will be accepted.**

Applications will be reviewed competitively and prioritized relative to demonstrated learning value in the project, relevance to the faculty member's overall research goals, potential for future work based on the project, possibility of contribution to presentation and/or publication, and justification of the requested budget items. There may not be sufficient funds to honor all requests. Awards are expected to be announced no later than April 14, 2017.
