HEALTH INSURANCE

As an international student, you are required to purchase and maintain health insurance that meets or exceeds the following: (1) pays a minimum of \$50,000 per accident or illness; (2) pays a minimum of \$10,000 for expenses associated with medical evacuation; (3) covers the cost of repatriation of at least \$7,500; (4) shall not have a deductible that exceeds \$500 per injury or illness; (5) provides equal benefits for both sexes (covers maternity costs without additional payments); (6) covers pre-existing conditions after no more than a six months' waiting period.
