**CRITERIA FOR SELECTION**

Candidate should be CSUS faculty, a K-12 teacher and/or counselor and fulfill the following criteria:

- An ability to relate to and experience in leading youth groups, especially high school age
- Multicultural/cultural awareness and sensitivity
- A bachelor's degree and at least 4 years of work/professional experience
- Interest/experience in international programs/education, especially related to Africa
- Good physical/mental health
- Conflict resolution skills
- Excellent leadership, communication and program development/management skills
- Experienced interpersonal skills

In addition, please submit one letter of reference from an employer and one letter of recommendation from a friend attesting to your character and reliability.

**RESPONSIBILITIES**

1. Develop, direct and manage youth peace project(s).
2. Work with student participants before, during and after programs in Ghana.
3. Serve as Guide Counselors to students while traveling in Ghana.
4. Participate in all project activities and programs, including pre-trip orientations, fundraising and post-trip activities.
5. Work with Ghana partners in carrying out programs.
6. Report to CAPCR Director, or designee as needed.
7. Engage in other duties necessary to carry out project tasks.
8. Participate in selection of high school and CSUS participants.

If selected, CAPCR will pay for the international airfare, lodging, meals and local group transportation in Ghana for the duration of the program.
