The Trustees of the California State University and the California State University, Sacramento will receive sealed bid proposals in the Facilities Services Office, at the above address for furnishing all labor and material for the renovation of the football field for the California State University, Sacramento.

Sealed proposals will be received in the Facilities Services Office on **Thursday, November 12, 2009 at 2:00 p.m.** in accordance with the contract documents, at which time the proposals will be publicly opened and read. The bid must be submitted on the Bid Proposal Forms provided by the University, completely filled out and sealed in an envelope, clearly marked with project name and Bid Package A, B, C, or D.

In general, the work consists of demolition of existing natural turf, replacing natural turf with a synthetic turf system. The project will require some electrical/telecom and irrigation replacement. The architects estimate for a total of all phases of the project is \$850,000.00 with a 95 day contract.

The project will be divided into 4 separate prime contracts. These contracts are as follows:

Bid Pack A – Demolition/Earthwork and Grading (Project Estimate: \$285,000) - Class A license required

Bid Pack B – Artificial Turf Installation (Project Estimate: \$400,000) – D-12 License required

Bid Pack C – Electrical/Telecom Improvements (Project Estimate: \$30,000) – C-10 and C-7 License required

Bid Pack D – Irrigation Improvements (Project Estimate: \$60,000) – C-27 license required

Each bidder offering a proposal must comply with bidding provisions of Article 2.00 et. seq. of the Contract General Conditions. The bidder should familiarize himself with all the provisions of the Contract General Conditions, especially Article 4.02 (c) regarding the prevailing wage rates.

A non-mandatory pre-bid walkthrough and conference will be held on **Thursday, October 29, 2009 at 10:00 a.m.** The meeting will be held at the Alumni Center on the California State University, Sacramento campus. It is strongly recommended that contractors and subcontractors attend the walkthrough, as it will be the only time bidders can visit the site with the Design Architect. Parking permits are available for purchase at machine located in parking lots

The Trustees require the successful bidder to achieve a minimum goal of 3% DVBE participation in contracting construction projects as established in the bidding documents. **Documentation of DVBE participation must be supplied within 2 days of the bid.** Questions regarding DVBE participation should be directed to Procurement Services, 6000 J Street, California State University, Sacramento, Sacramento, CA 95819-6008: Attention Ms. Suzanne Swartz, telephone (916) 278-5797.
