FALL 2017 UNIT CAP UPDATE - April 5, 2017

There are three registration periods for Fall 2017, Early – Priority Registration May 1 – June 2. Open Registration and Schedule Adjustment August 14 – 24; and Late Registration and Schedule Adjustment August 28 – September 8. **Continuing student registration will be closed May 20-29 for Spring grading.**

In order to ensure that all students have a chance to develop a full schedule, there is an initial Unit Cap for all students:

Please Note: The Unit Cap is a conservative approach in allowing all students, including new students attending Orientation, a chance to develop a full schedule. During Priority Registration a student may register for a limited number of units. Please consult with your advisor as you review your degree plan and your progress to degree. Seniors will be assigned their registration appointment based on their Progress to Degree (P2D) points.
