The Research and Creative Activity Subcommittee of the Faculty Senate administers an annual competition to support faculty research, scholarly, and creative activity, and encourage faculty contributions to their disciplines. Approximately \$300,000 is anticipated to be available from the CSU Chancellor's Office and the Office of Research Affairs for the 2018-19 academic year.

Eligible Projects

Award recipients must produce a scholarly deliverable, such as an article or manuscript to be submitted for peer-reviewed publication, or a grant proposal, juried exhibition, performance, etc.

Faculty Eligibility

All Unit 3 faculty (including full-time faculty, part-time faculty, temporary faculty, probationary and tenured faculty, lecturers, coaches, librarians, and counselors, as outlined in the Unit 3 Bargaining Agreement) are eligible and encouraged to apply. Faculty are also encouraged to volunteer to serve as faculty peer reviewers for the program.

Awards

Faculty (individually or in teams) may apply for the following types of support for use in academic year 2018-19 (amount totals will be set by the RCA Subcommittee in fall 2017):

- Assigned Time (for fall 2018 and spring 2019)
- Summer Research Salary (for summer 2019)
- Research Support Funds for project-related expenses (travel, student assistants, materials and supplies, equipment, manuscript or page charges, etc.)
