2009-10 STEM FACULTY FELLOWS PROGRAM CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

Applications are now being accepted **through noon on May 26th** for the 2009-2010 STEM Faculty Fellows program, which supports the development of innovative faculty proposals for STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) activity on campus. The program is available to *full-time tenured or tenure-track* faculty members who are able to write integrative and innovative grant proposals in the following areas:

1. Program Development for Pathways into STEM Careers
2. Student Retention and Success in STEM disciplines
3. STEM Equipment and Infrastructure
4. STEM Education Enhancement (including Math/Science Teacher Recruitment and Preparation)
5. Research in a STEM Discipline

Successful STEM Faculty Fellows will receive three units (3 WTU) of assigned time during 2009-10 to develop and submit a grant proposal that advances the individual or collective STEM disciplines on campus. Between six and ten awards for 2009-10 will be available for use in either fall 2009 or spring 2010 at the Fellow's discretion.
