

Annual Report for July 1, 2015 - June 30, 2016 *

Each Campus will report the following annually on October 1, for the prior fiscal year (July 1 to June 30), without disclosing any information that would reveal the identities of the parties involved:

1. The number of Sexual Misconduct, Dating and Domestic Violence, and Stalking reports received in which a Student is the Respondent; TOTAL = 27
2. The number of Sexual Misconduct, Dating and Domestic Violence, and Stalking reports received in which an Employee is the Respondent; TOTAL = 2
3. The number of Sexual Misconduct, Dating and Domestic Violence, and Stalking reports investigated; TOTAL = 22
4. The number of Sexual Misconduct, Dating and Domestic Violence, and Stalking reports resolved without investigation, including a description of the resolution and/or reason for no investigation; Early Resolution = 1; Other (No Cooperation, No Campus Connection, Unknown Assailant, etc.) = 33
5. The number of Sexual Misconduct, Dating and Domestic Violence, and Stalking investigations in which the Respondent was held responsible, including a description of the final sanction; TOTAL = 16 (Student Probation = 3; Student Suspension = 9; Student Expulsion = 1; Student Voluntary Withdrawal = 1; Employee Termination = 1; Employee Written Counseling/Censor Memo = 1).

Sanctions for the above-referenced students were as follows:

- a. 1 semester suspension, no contact order, stay away from campus housing.
- b. 1 yr probation.
- c. Expulsion.
- d. Voluntary withdrawal from University, no re-enrollment, banned from University premises.
- e. Suspended 1 academic year, not allowed to join clubs for 1 year after reenrollment, must take sex violence training and write reflective paper immediately upon re-enrollment.
- f. Suspended 1 semester & agreement not to re-enroll.
- g. One semester suspension; no contact order, re-take online sexual harassment training.
- h. One year suspension, no contact order, probation on re-enrollment, stay away from campus housing.
- i. One semester suspension, required to provide proof of court sanctioned domestic or dating violence prevention class or proof of meeting with Sac State Student Health Counseling Director for similar training.
- j. Suspension for one semester, no contact order; required to provide proof of court sanctioned domestic or dating violence prevention class or proof of meeting with Sac State Student Health Counseling Director for similar training.
- k. 1 semester probation, re-take sexual harassment training.
- l. 2 semester suspension, probation until graduation, retake alcohol education course.
- m. 1 semester suspension, probation, mandatory meetings with Student Conduct Director to discuss appropriate behavior.
- n. 1 semester suspension, no contact order; probation through graduation, required to provide proof of court sanctioned domestic or dating violence prevention class or

proof of meeting with Sac State Student Health Counseling Director for similar training. retake alcohol education.

6. The number of Sexual Misconduct, Dating and Domestic Violence, and Stalking investigations in which the evidence was found insufficient to hold the Respondent responsible. TOTAL = 7

The information shall be reported in a manner that protects the privacy of the persons involved, including victims, Respondents, and witnesses, and shall be posted on the Campus web site.

*These statistics are provided in compliance with Executive Order 1095, revised 6-23-15. They are for the period July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016 while Clery statistics in the University's Annual Security and Fire Safety Report are reported for the 2015 calendar year as required by federal law. Reports to the Office of the Title IX Coordinator may be related to incidents which did not take place on Clery defined geography, therefore the statistics in this report may not coincide with Clery statistics in the Annual Security and Fire Safety Report.
