ON CAMPUS HOUSING COSTS & MEAL PLAN

Total cost includes Rent (amount based on room type assignment) and Board (Meal Plan amount). Prices include rent for space in a furnished room/suite from August through December and January through May (student vacates during Winter Break, but can leave their belongings in the room/suite), all utilities, access to Wi-Fi, and Xfinity TV and DVR style service. Price for Meal Plan is for Fall and Spring semesters.

DISBURSEMENT & REFUND PROCESS

It is the student's responsibility to accept/decline aid offers, and clear Financial Aid Holds and To Do List items on their account to ensure aid is disbursed in a timely manner.

DISBURSEMENTS: Financial aid usually pays out one week before the start of the semester. Payment of aid is based on accepted awards and enrolled units (excludes wait-list classes). Aid will always be applied towards outstanding charges FIRST. If there are remaining funds after the balance is paid, a refund will be issued to the student.

REFUNDS: Financial aid refunds are issued as a paper check to the address on file. The student has the option to sign up for direct deposit (eRefund) to have funds transferred to their bank account instead. Students can sign-up on their My Sac State account.

- Student Paper-check refunds: receive within 5-7 business days from the disbursement date.
- · Student ERefund (direct deposit): receive within 2-3 business days from the disbursement date to the bank account on file.
- Parent PLUS Loan refunds: issued as a paper check, direct deposit is currently not offered.
