Who are Pell-eligible students?

- Federal Pell Grants are given to undergraduate students with financial need (low-income) who do not have a bachelor's graduate, or professional degree.
- Pell Grant eligibility is determined after completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- The amount you get depends on your Expected Family Contribution (EFC), the cost of attendance at your school, your status as a full-time or part-time student, and whether you plan to attend school for a full academic year or less.
- 2022-2023 EFC \$6,206
- 2022-2023 award \$6,895
- There is no age limit for the Pell Grant.




A landscape of Pell-eligible students at Sac State.
