Work groups are actively collecting data and evidence to complete compliance worksheets while engaging the university community in the data-collection process across divisions. Looking ahead to spring 2026, the Steering Committee will continue drafting the institutional report and conduct briefing meetings to share updates and gather input from the university community.
