What is ROTC?

Offered at more than 1,100 colleges and universities across the country, Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC) develops the leaders of tomorrow by preparing students to become officers in the U.S. Air Force and Space Force while earning a college degree.



What are the Requirements?

- U.S. citizen or obtain citizenship by contract date
- Good moral character
- Enrolled in an accredited college that hosts or has a crosstown agreement with the Detachment
- Full-time student (12 credit hrs or 9 credit hrs for undergraduate or graduate degrees, respectfully)
- Pass the Air Force Fitness Assessment (waist measurement, push-ups, sit-ups, 1.5 mile run)
- Pass the Air Force Officer Qualifying Test (AFOQT)



Weekly Schedule

Other than attending your college classes, you must attend weekly:

- **Aerospace Studies Lecture:** Learn Air Force history, leadership, and other lessons that prepare you to be a commissioned officer
- **Leadership Laboratory:** Practice leadership skills in a laboratory planned & executed by cadets
- **Physical Training:** twice a week
