

MORE CLASSES AND FLEXIBILITY WITH CSU FULLY ONLINE

Take a Class at Another CSU—Online!

CSU Fully Online lets eligible students take **one online course per term** at another CSU university while staying enrolled at their home campus. It's a smart way to access courses that may be full or unavailable at your CSU, take advantage of flexible scheduling, and stay on track to graduate.

You're Eligible for CSU Fully Online If You:

- ✓ Have completed at least one term as a matriculated student in a state-supported program and earned at least 12 units at your CSU.
- ✓ Have a campus GPA of at least 2.0 and are in good standing.
- ✓ Are enrolled at your home CSU during the term you take the online course.
- ✓ Are enrolled in more than 6 units and have either paid your tuition or have financial aid on the way.

NOTE:

Incoming transfer students are eligible their first term and do not need to meet the 12-unit requirement.

Finding Courses:

- Visit www.csufullyonline.com to explore online courses offered across the CSU system.
- Search by subject, keyword (from the course title or description), GE requirement, or previously approved equivalencies.
- The default view shows Open Courses, those with available seats as of the last site refresh. Change the view to display All Courses to see Open and Closed offerings.
- Read course descriptions carefully for prerequisites, meeting dates, and any synchronous (real-time) session requirements.
- All courses are transferable but check with your advisor to confirm how credit will apply to your degree.

How to Enroll:

- Log in to your Student Center and click the CSU Fully Online link. Search for a course and submit your enrollment request.
- Courses only appear during the host campus's enrollment window, if you don't see a course, confirm the Enrollment Period listed for course/CSU.
- You may be asked to verify prerequisites directly with the host CSU after submitting your request.
- Once your request is processed, your enrollment status will update in the CSU Fully Online section of your Student Center.
- If you're enrolled, you'll receive a welcome email from the host campus within two days.
