This program proposal is to request a change in the admission requirements to the program because a number of non-CSU
Sacramento matriculated individuals have expressed interest in the program, and the high unit-count has prohibited otherwise qualified applicants from entering the program. The admission requirements are being made to 1) increase number of program applicants; 2) expand the program offering, so individuals who did or did not matriculate at CSU Sacramento can apply; 3) align the minimum number of units completed for admission with minimum number of transferable credits; and 4) clarify completed GE/GR coursework

2. Must not have been enrolled at university for at least 1 academic year
3. Completed at least 70 units of coursework (may be upper or lower division units).
4. Completed all lower division General Education (GE) for California State University system or equivalent. A condition of admission to the program is that students have completed all lower-division GE requirements plus second-semester composition (ENGL 20) or equivalents from another institution.
5. Have a minimum cumulative GPA not lower than 2.0.
