Briefly describe the program proposal (new or change) and provide a justification:

This change proposal is to correct two errors made when this program was entered into the nextcatalog system. There is no change to the actual program.

1) The title of this program was entered into the system incorrectly; it was never an ADN-BSN program. This is a non-degree program required by California regulation. By regulation, it is capped at 30-units. I am unable to change the "Designation: (degree terminology)" to indicate it is a non-degree program.

2) When we suspended the RN-BSN track B, this program was incorrectly marked as suspended. This program is required by regulation and we never requested it be suspended.

Students are admitted into this option when there is space available in our 2nd semester BSN program. There are no classes only for these students thus no fiscal impact. We have not had students admitted and continue in the past few years so do not have program assessment or budget projections to attach.

Objectives of the degree program:

Per California regulation, this non-degree awarding program allows Licensed Vocational Nurses (LVNs) to take 30 units of nursing education in order to be eligible to test for a Registered Nurse license. Since it is not a program, there are no program objectives.
