Briefly describe the program proposal (new or change) and provide a justification:
All Philosophy concentrations are being revised for the following reasons: (1) To achieve greater uniformity across the concentrations in core subject and total unit requirements; (2) to respond to a recent program review suggestion to create a required entry level Philosophical Methods (PHIL 89) course that will both prepare majors for advanced study and serve as an entry level assessment vehicle in conjunction with our Senior Seminar (PHIL 189). (3) To better prepare majors for advanced study by creating uniform prerequisites to upper division core courses. The 2 unit increase in the General Concentration results from the addition of PHIL 89. This will not require additional resources. Indeed we ultimately expect the preparatory value of this course to facilitate more timely graduation.

To provide a strong foundation in philosophy for majors, stressing clear, rigorous, impartial and systematic thought.
