Briefly describe the program proposal (new or change) and provide a justification:

We have edited the lower-division course requirements so that the Art History minor reflects exactly the art history lower-division course requirements in the BA in Art History and the BFA in Studio Art. This will help students move more seamlessly between a minor and a major or vice versa.

Previously, the catalogue for this minor just said to select 9 units of upper-division art history courses; we have decided to list these courses out so it will be more transparent for students. We have also added two new courses to the list, ART 172 (African American Art and Visual Culture), a new course created in response to student demand for more diverse course offerings, and ART 190, a course on the history of animation globally, which is also a result of student demand.

Our PLOs were not previous listed on this form, so they were added.

Program Description

The Minor in Art History will allow students to explore historical and contemporary art in a globally-oriented curriculum. The 21-unit degree includes a solid grounding in lower-division art history courses, where students will learn to identify major artists and art movements and begin to interpret and analyze art within various historical contexts. At the upper-division level, students select nine units of coursework, which allows them to focus on a particular area of art history and/or supplement their study with hands-on skills in curatorial studies courses or internships. The Minor in Art History provides students with skills and knowledge that will complement many other majors; these skills include visual literacy, research skills, writing, and critical thinking.

Admission Requirements: Course prerequisites and other criteria for admission of students to the degree major program, and for their continuation in it.

Minimum Grade Requirement

A grade of "C" or better is required for all courses applied to the Minor in Art History.
