The number of students enrolled in the Musical Theatre minor has declined significantly. It is also fiscally challenging to continue to offer all classes required for the minor on a consistent basis.

This is a departmental program that includes classes from Dance. As a department faculty, we have consulted and agreed that the Musical Theatre Minor is not a viable program.
