Information and Disclaimers

Professional Development Stipends (PDS) are none pensionable, are taxable, and eligible for benefits deductions. Faculty Unit 3 participants must complete the stated terms in full to be eligible for payment. Work completed during a PDS does not count towards entitlement or workload, and cannot be considered during faculty review or consideration for course assignments unless included in CV. All work produced during a PDS is subject to Intellectual Property Rights controlled by Article 39 of the CFA CBA. Total PDS awards, per faculty member, per fiscal year, cannot exceed \$10,000. FERP faculty and Retired Annuitants are ineligible for PDS awards/payments, as are staff. All other unit 3 faculty must have an active appointment to be eligible.
