

#### **DIRECTIONS TO THE SAC STATE CAMPUS**

#### Eastbound Highway 50

Exit at Power Inn/Howe Avenue. Go under the freeway onto Homet Drive. Turn left onto College Town Drive. The road becomes State University Drive and you are on the south end of campus.
