Printsmart issue: Ron mentioned that students have been complaining about long delays (up to 2 hours) when using Printsmart, particularly from wireless devices. A new rendering software is going to be put in place within the next few weeks and will hopefully improve performance in the spring semester. Larry Gilbert also said that Printsmart goes through the OneCard system and that system is old and slow. They are evaluating and hopefully implementing a newer, better system which should help solve several problems.
