Exterior Art Procedures

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Any artwork shall be architecturally or artistically significant to overall campus design.
- 2. The artwork shall be compatible with the approved Campus Physical Master Plan as to scale, size and location.
- 3. Subject matter or theme of such artwork shall be directed to achieving long-term public acceptance as an appropriate artistic expression.
- 4. Materials of such artworks shall be compatible with that used on the campus.
- 5. The artwork shall be structurally sound and maintainable.
- 6. The highest quality of workmanship and care shall be used in the production and placement of such artworks.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Design of the artwork in final form shall be submitted to the Campus Minor Design Change Committee for consideration of art form, materials, location, quality of workmanship and costs involved.
- 2. Prior to consideration by the above committee, the President may form an ad-hoc review committee or jury to consider the particular work. Such body shall submit a written report and long-term maintenance plane to the Minor Design Change Committee.
- 3. The artwork, after consideration by the Minor Design Change Committee, shall be submitted to the President for final approval. Submittal shall include photographs, a rendering or model of the artwork and a statement when available by the artist as to his/her intent in creating the artwork.
