TOPIC: FDW Moving to Cloud Environment

The Finance Data Warehouse has moved to an Oracle Analytics Cloud version on January 27th. The link in MySacState has been updated to point to this new version. Although the Oracle version is very similar to the older edition, the Chancellor's Office has improved some features as detailed below.

New Features:

- 1) Typing in the search box now populates possible values:
