WHAT IS SB 1383?

- Builds on the success of AB32
- Aims to reduce food waste being sent to the landfill
- Diverts leftover food to those that need it

WHY IS SB1383 IMPORTANT?

- Each year Californians throw out 6 million tons of food waste, this waste creates harmful greenhouse gas emissions as it decomposes in landfills.



HOW SAC STATE IS COMPLYING

- We have invested in three-stream recycling bins for campus-generated trash, mixed recyclables, and post-consumer food waste.



WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR YOU?

- Place food waste in **compost bins** and put all other waste in the **proper containers**
