Technology (ICT) review is a required
evaluation process to determine whether a
new or renewing technology conforms with
applicable accessibility and security standards
and supports inclusive practices (when
applicable).

ICT requests are submitted through
ServiceNow and are required for all potential
ICT acquisitions that the university will
develop, acquire, maintain, or use regardless of
whether there is a cost involved.

- Computers
 Desktop, laptops, and tablets
- Self-contained products
 Printers, copiers, kiosks, scanners, portable projectors, transaction machines
- Software, web content, and mobile apps
- Telecommunications products
 Phone, VOIP, any product that communicates to students
- Video and multimedia materials
 Videos need to be captioned if they will be publicly available and/or used in a course with a student with an accommodation for captioned videos





ICT Request – Inclusivity Updates

To align with Sac State's support for all students, faculty, and staff to declare their individual gender identification and preferred name, the ICT Request Form will include a section titled "Diversity, Equity, and Inclusivity Evaluation" with the below questions if the ICT category is Cloud Services, Mobile Applications, Software Applications, and/or User Accounts:

Does this application require use of a legal name? If so, does the application also support a preferred name?

Does this system support gender pronouns?

Does this application collect gender information? (Gender information must include non-binary.) If yes, please include a reason.



ICT Request Form – Other Updates



- A new field, **Vendor contact information (if available)** will be added to the request form to save time should a reviewer need to contact the vendor for further information/documentation.
- The current Accessibility
 Documentation header will be changed to Vendor-Supplied
 Accessibility Documentation to clarify the responsibility of the vendor to provide this information.
