Change beginning Fall 2023

NOT CHANGING . . .

The deadline for students to be able to add and drop their own classes online remains the end of the second week of the term – September 8th

CURRENTLY . . .

If a student drops to half-time after the end of the second week:


- They would remain responsible for full-time fees
- They would have to appeal for reconsideration
- Their financial aid would be reduced

ONLY CHANGE . . .

Students will continue to receive credit for dropped courses through census date

BENEFITS

- Fee charges will align with financial aid award
- Additional time for students/departments to drop courses
- Reduction in appeals for fee charges
