

OnBase Access Options

I would like to know more about OnBase access. The OnBase website states a Service Now ticket is required for OnBase access, but there is no list of what access can be requested. It would be very helpful is there was a list, like the one for requesting CARS access so I know what to request for Staff and Dept. Chairs in my area. For new hires, I would like to request CARS and OnBase access all at once so they have access to OnBase forms such as Add/Drop petitions, Graduation Applications, Change of Major, etc. as needed without any delays.



Response

Though Financial Services uses OnBase for many of our forms and processes, it is an IRT property. We have reached out to them for direction on the comment.



IRT Response

Currently CARS and OnBase access are separate requests. IRT is working on eventually combining the CARS access and the OnBase access requests in the future. Regarding OnBase access, there is no list that outlines all the OnBase access that is available. The OnBase team have discussed creating a request form similar to the CARS form for CMS; but that has not come to fruition yet.

Since OnBase access is based on User groups rather than individual staff access, it would be helpful to provide the necessary user groups which the user needs along with the supervisor approval for the request. In the event that the requester isn't familiar with the user groups, provide the name of a staff member with the similar access helps the OnBase team in determining the user groups needed for the user.

I hope this helps. Please let us know if you need further assistance.
