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3. Please include the Certificate of Insurance when you return the Contract as required by Article 3.04 of the Contract General Conditions for Major Capital Outlay Projects (General Conditions). Ensure that the certificate indicates the coverage as required under Article 4.06 of the General Conditions. Attached is a sample endorsement containing all of the stipulations in Article 4.06-c, which may be attached to the insurance certificate by your insurance broker for your convenience. Should your insurance broker decline using this endorsement, please use it as a guideline for determining whether all provisions are included. Failure to include all provisions will prevent execution of this contract.

4. Please return, the signed Contract with the bonds attached, to this office within ten (10) working days. We will forward your executed copy to you after approval by our legal department.

You are reminded that no contract shall be binding upon the Trustees until it has been approved by the attorney appointed according to law and authorized to represent the Trustees (Contract General Conditions Article 3.04, Execution of Contract, and Public Contract Code section 10820). The Notice to Proceed, which starts the contract time of performance, will be issued within fifteen days of the contract's approval by our legal department.

  - (b) Automobile Liability:

- (2) For any claims related to the work, the Contractor's insurance coverage shall be primary insurance as respects the State of California, the Trustees of the California State University, the University, their officers, employees, representatives, volunteers, and agents. Any insurance or self-insurance maintained by the State of California, the Trustees of the California State University, the University, their officers, employees, representatives, volunteers, and agents shall be in excess of the Contractor's insurance and shall not contribute with it.
- (3) The Contractor shall immediately upon receipt of any notice of cancellation or any notice of non-renewal of any insurance required under this Article 35.06, provide written notice of any such insurance cancellation or non-renewal by certified mail to the University.
- (4) The State of California, the Trustees of the California State University, the University, their officers, employees, representatives, volunteers, and agents shall not by reason of their inclusion as additional insureds incur liability to the insurance carriers for payment of premiums for such insurance.
