You don't need official training to start using it. Accessing LinkedIn Learning through My Sac State's Single Sign-On (SSO) ensures the security of your personal information, however, the university will not track your LinkedIn Learning participation or viewed content. Please keep in mind that this product is not CSU Learn, the university's compliance training site also accessed through My Sac State. As a reminder, be sure to check with your manager to ensure operational needs will be covered while you are working on professional development in the LinkedIn Learning platform.
