Update to the Drive-in Wi-Fi in Parking Structure 5 Service

In support of Sacramento State's rapid transition to a "Virtual University," we are now offering Eduroam Wi-Fi access in Parking Structure 5 on a first-come, first-served basis. To facilitate, promote, and support full access to this new service, we have revised our procedures. A parking permit will **NOT** be required if you are in your vehicle utilizing Wi-Fi to access Eduroam.

Here's how it works:

- Wi-Fi access begins **Friday, March 27: 10 a.m.- 4 p.m., Monday-Friday.**
- While the recommendation remains to stay home if possible, this opportunity is a special exception if there isn't an alternative for completing your coursework. This is for studying only and is not a place to gather socially. You must practice the same social distancing with your vehicle as you do with people (6 feet or more), as well as to observe basic courtesy rules (stay in your vehicle with the ignition off, no loud music, no smoking/drinking, no sleeping, or overnight privileges).
- Drive into Parking Structure 5, and follow the signs/cones for parking options on Floors 2-6.
- For the best reception, we recommend parking at the outer edges of the structure (not the ramps).
- Connect to the campus network, Eduroam - and visit csus.edu/wireless if you need help.
- The Sacramento State Police Department will patrol the structure during open hours for added security, but be sure to familiarize yourself with these [safety precautions](#).
