I. Introductions – All

II. Senate Bill 54, Immigration Violations, and Sac State PD Policy 413 – Chief Madison

- i. Senate Bill 54 ensures that no state or local resources are used to assist federal immigration enforcement, which ensures that Sacramento State Police Department will not and cannot take part in immigration enforcement without a judicial warrant.
- ii. Policy 413.1 requires that CSU police officers shall not contact, detail, question, or arrest individuals solely on the basis of known or suspected immigration status.
- iii. Policy 413.4 requires that officers shall not inquire into an individual's immigration status.
- iv. Policy 412.7 requires that the Sacramento State Police Department will not enter into agreements with state or local law enforcement agencies, ICE, or any other federal agency for the enforcement of federal immigration.

III. Training Exercise for Active Shooter and Mass Casualty Events – Chief Madison and Sergeant Mayes

- i. On February 25th, 2025 we held a second Active Shooter Awareness Training presentation in the Union.
 - a. More people are interested, so we may hold a second presentation this semester.
- ii. We will be holding our fourth annual full-scale Active Shooter Training Exercise on Tuesday, April 1st, 2025.
