

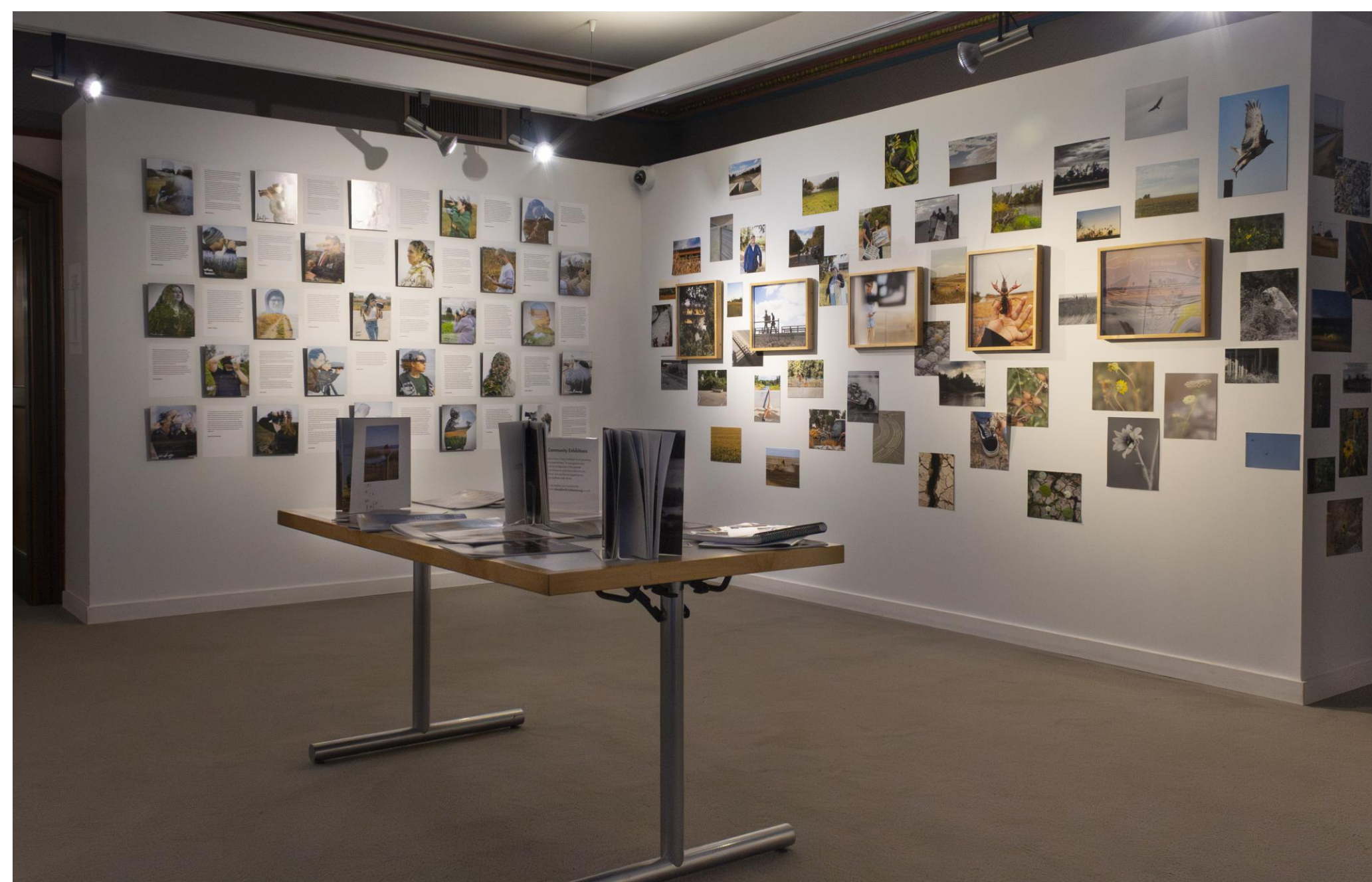
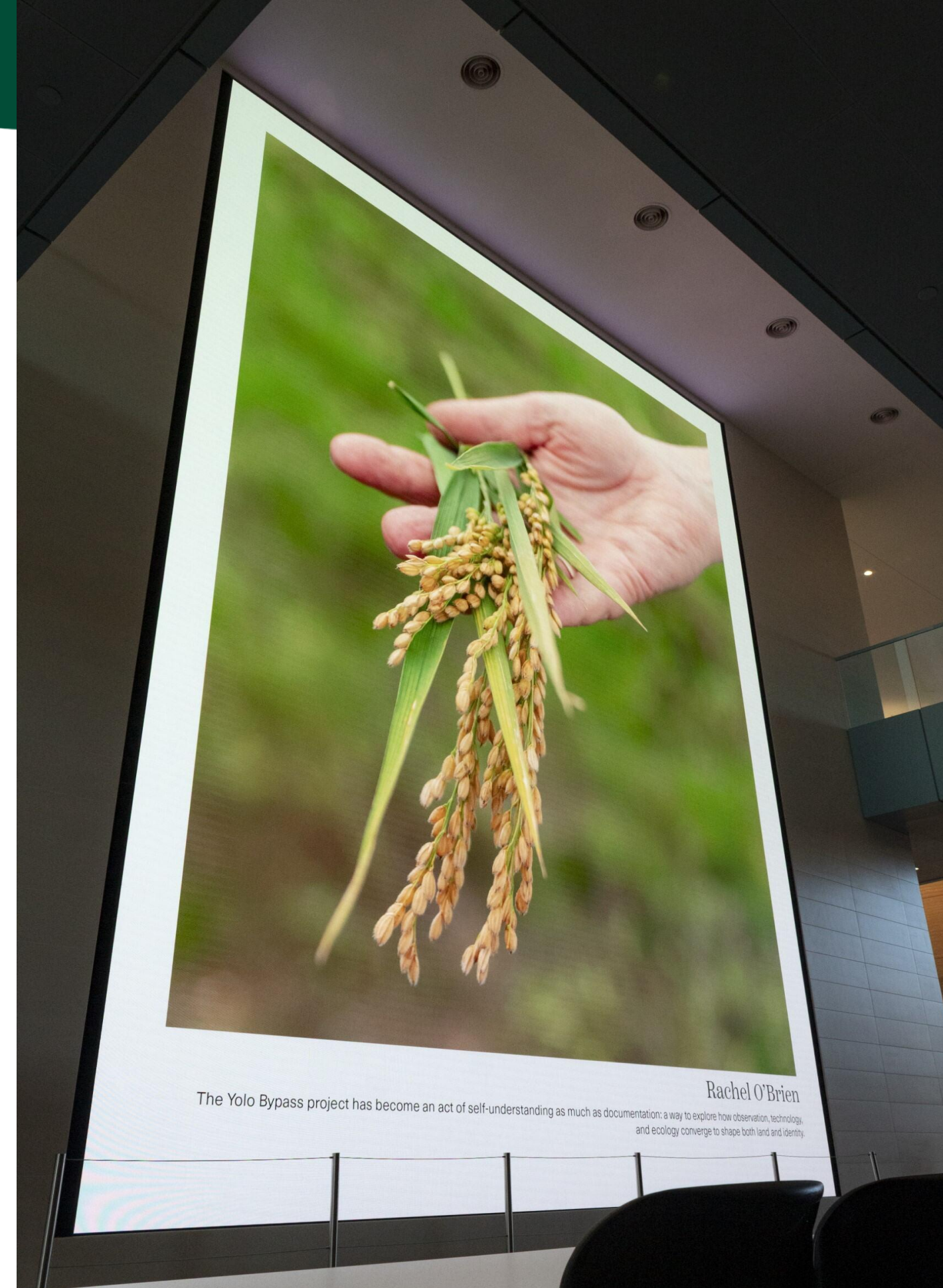
# 2026 COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT SHOWCASE

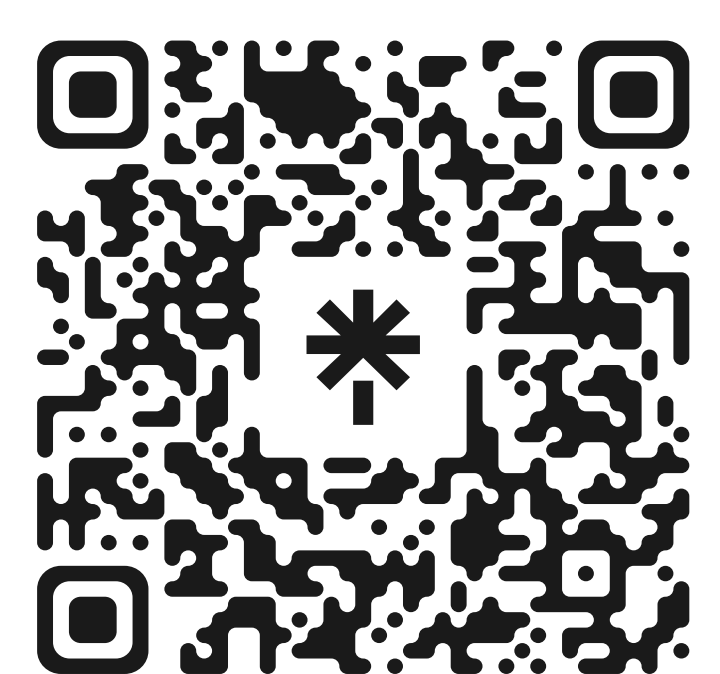
