## Residents in Our County...

83%

## Homelessness in Our Region

A Point-in-Time (PIT) Count is conducted regularly by each county to understand how many people are experiencing sheltered and unsheltered homelessness on a given night. The latest count<sup>1</sup> estimated there were 284 individuals experiencing homelessness in El Dorado County with 48% of the individuals unsheltered at the time (i.e., living outside, in a tent, or car).

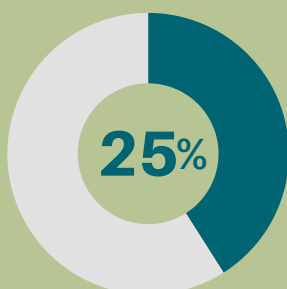

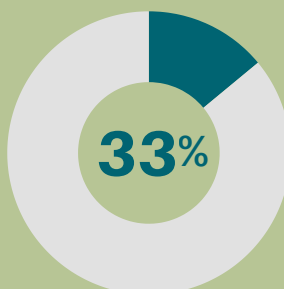

## Residents routinely see signs of homelessness in their local communities.

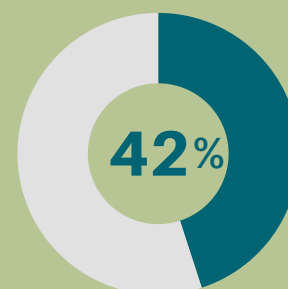
Over the past year, 58% of residents saw **signs of homelessness and unhoused individuals** once a week or more often.

At least **once a week**

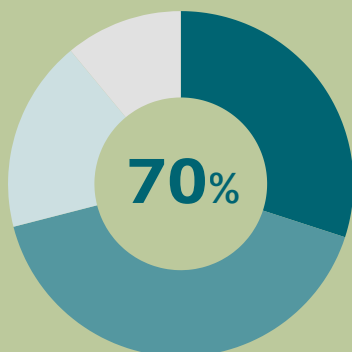


Few **times a month** or less

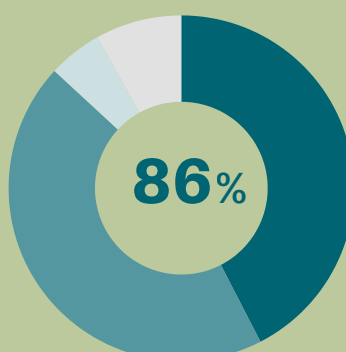
## Homelessness was a key voting issue in the last election.

A large majority of residents reported that they **strongly** considered or **somewhat** considered the issue of homelessness when voting.

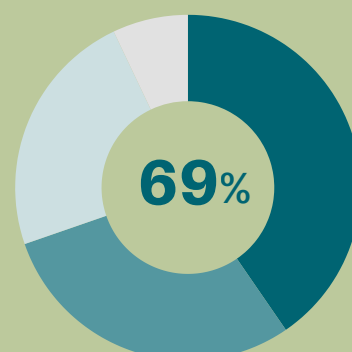
in **local** elections



in **state** elections



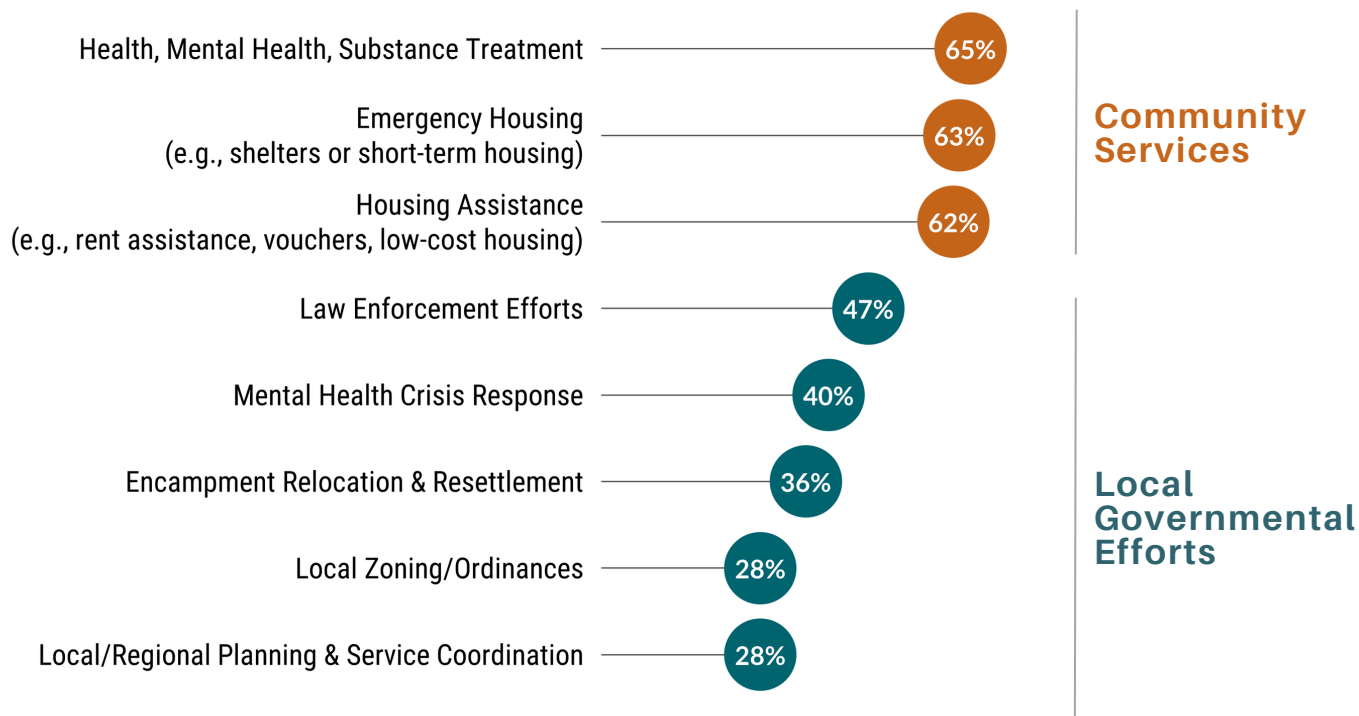
in **federal** elections

## There is a gap between residents' awareness of community services vs. local governmental efforts.

For example, while **63%** of residents in El Dorado County are aware of local **Emergency Housing**, about half as many (**28%**) know of **Local/Regional Planning & Service Coordination** to address homelessness.



The Institute for Social Research at Sacramento State surveyed 1,750 households across the Greater Sacramento Region to better understand residents' awareness and perceptions related to the issue of homelessness. Findings in this brief are based on the 145 households in El Dorado County. This poll was conducted during March-April 2025 and has a margin of error of 2.3%.
