COVID 19 Restrictions and Recommendations for attending this event

Sac State recommends that all students, staff, faculty, and visitors be vaccinated for COVID-19.

Attendees will be required to show proof of vaccination or a negative Covid test result within 48 hours of the event and photo ID.

Vaccination & Negative Test Verification

How do I show vaccination status?

• Provide vaccine cards (physical, digital, or digital COVID-19 Vaccine Record) with photo ID card.

Where can I get digital COVID-19 Vaccine Record?

https://myvaccinerecord.cdph.ca.gov/

Complete the required fields with first name, last name, date of birth, and phone or email associated with your vaccine card (you would have provided this information when you first got your vaccine).

Once the form is complete, they will receive a text message or email to retrieve their digital vaccine record that is valid for 24 hours. Type in your chosen 4-digit PIN and you will receive a record with QR code (for verification purposes with SMART Health Card app reader) and doses received.

What do I need to show a negative test result?

- PCR tests are done through a lab. Results should be within 48 hours of the event. Results can be provided as a sheet of paper or digital form with results, name, and date and time of when the test was taken.
- An attestation form completed by a test site is acceptable for negative antigen/rapid tests. The form should include name, date, and time of when the test was taken and reviewed. Sac State employees who are required to test or want to take a test at our employee test site can request a form.
- Antigen/rapid tests are often done at home. Guests must write their name, date, and time of when they took the home test right on the test strip. Take a picture of the negative test strip and show alongside a photo ID and provide as evidence.

After March 18th, masks are no longer required indoors. However, for this event we will require that you to use a mask in certain locations such as when grabbing food and when going around the tables and speaking to the community organizations. Masks and other PPE will be available to those who need or want it at the event. Changes in the COVID-19 Safety Guidelines may occur on the day of the event. If you are sick or experiencing symptoms of illness, please refrain from attending this event.
