### **VACANCY CALL**

The Department of Art anticipates a need for part-time instructors in **AY 2021-2022** (Fall 2021 and Spring 2022 semesters). Salary rate is variable depending upon qualifications and relevant experience.

The [Department of Art](#) is part of the [College of Arts and Letters](#). At the undergraduate level, it offers the BA degree in Art (concentrations in Art History and Studio Art; Art Education program that prepares students to earn the Single Subject Teaching Credential in Art for grades K-12) and the BFA degree in Art Studio. At the graduate level, it offers the MA degree in Studio Art. The Art Department is accredited by the National Association of Art and Design (NASAD).

Applicants for teaching positions in **all three areas must provide the following**. Please note the additional information required in the sections (I., II, III.) below.

1. *Letter of Interest*, listing courses you are prepared to teach.
2. *Complete curriculum vitae (CV)*.
3. *Dates & Summaries* of relevant teaching experience (provide listing of comparable college classes taught).
4. Sample *syllabi* for each course listed in your Letter of Interest (comparable college courses accepted).
5. *References* – names & contact information for (3) references who can address your teaching skills.

- I. Art Education:** Teach undergraduate classes in Art Education for Children and Secondary Art Education, all with content conforming to national and California visual art standards. Visit the Sacramento State [catalog](#) for a full list of art education courses. Teaching experience required (public school teaching experience and/or college teaching experience in art education preferred.) M.A. degree in Art Education required, Art Education doctoral degree

preferred (M.F.A. degree in Studio Art accepted with K-12 teaching experience.) **In addition to the application materials outlined above, include 20 JPG images (maximum) of your work and/or your students' work** (on a flash-drive, with a hard copy identifying each image) and a self-addressed stamped envelope (SASE) for the return of the flash-drive.

**II.** **Art History:** Teach undergraduate classes in Western and non-Western art, criticism, and visual culture from pre-history to the present and from many perspectives. Visit the Sacramento State [catalog](#) for a full list of art history courses. M.A. and college teaching experience in art history required, Ph.D. preferred. Ph.D. required to teach upper division courses.

**III.** **Studio Art:** Teach undergraduate classes in art and visual culture, ceramics, drawing & painting, new media art, printmaking, and sculpture. Visit the Sacramento State [catalog](#) for a full list of art studio courses. M.F.A. in studio art required, college teaching experience preferred. For new media art applicants, see footnote below\*. **In addition to the application materials outlined above, include 20 JPG images of your work and 20 JPG images of your students' work on a flash-drive (with a hard copy list identifying each image; if 20 student images are not available, please explain),** and a self-addressed stamped envelope (SASE) for the return of the flash-drive.

**\*For all applications with videos or JPG images:** Each JPG should be less than 2.5 megabytes and sized to 1024 pixels (14.22 inches) on the longest side, at 72ppi. For videos, any documentation must be on Vimeo.
