The Award:

The Patricia Aeschliman McGreal Memorial Endowed Scholarship was created in memory of Mrs. Patricia Aeschliman McGreal, a beloved patron of the art community and long-time member of the Sacramento State Hornet family.

The Patricia Aeschliman McGreal Memorial Endowed Scholarship is a **\$800.00 award** to support an outstanding undergraduate or graduate Art student. The Art Department Scholarship Committee will select one awardee per year.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Undergraduate or Graduate at California State University, Sacramento (Sophomore, Junior, Senior, or Graduate)
- Declared major in Art (any concentration: BFA in Art Studio, BA in Studio Art Methods, Art Education, or Art History)
- Student must be in good academic standing with the University.
- Part-time or Full-time enrollment at Sacramento State in Spring 2022
- Financial need is not required but will be considered, if applicable
- Student recipient(s) are eligible to reapply for the scholarship award and receive the scholarship up to two years.

Application Materials (submitted via [AcademicWorks](#)):

- General Application
- Portfolio with the following components in order (in one PDF that is less than 10 MB in size):
 1. A 100- to 250-word reflection essay introducing the work submitted in #2
 2. Examples of creative **OR** scholarly work within the applicant's area of study:
 - Ten large, high-quality images of the applicant's art work with captions (give the title, medium, and year for each work) **OR**
 - Two samples of the applicant's writing from any art history, studio art, or art education course
- **Optional**: A 100- to 250-word statement about the applicant's financial need
