We connect CSU students with over 300 entertainment industry employers to facilitate meaningful internship experiences for campus to career success.

Internships are available in all areas including: production, post-production, marketing, animation, design, journalism, programming, public relations, television and film development, sports, performing arts, music, radio, broadcast news, social media, accounting, management, data & computer science, and many more!

The CSUEA Internship Program is an excellent option for students who:

- Are lower division freshmen or sophomores
- Are not eligible to enroll in an upper division internship course
- Are graduating in May but still want to complete a post-graduate summer internship
- Are enrolled in an internship class but need assistance securing an internship
- Need school credit for an internship they have already identified
- Are considering different majors and want to explore the Entertainment Industry landscape
- Want a summer work experience at an L.A. area company, attend a non-local CSU campus & need housing assistance.

Low-Cost Internship Class for Credit

- Enrollment eligibility includes all currently registered CSU students & those who have graduated within the last 2 years.
- Earn 3 units for completing a minimum of 90 internship hours for a low \$200 enrollment fee
- San Francisco State University College of Extended Learning offers this LCA 576 course year-round
- The LCA 576 course may be repeated up to 3 times, for a maximum of 9 units
