This Scholarship was created in honor of Ms. Theresa Mary McCourt, an accomplished writer, teacher, business woman, athlete, gardner, wife, mother and friend. She graduated with her Master's Degree in English from Sacramento State in 1989.

Availability

When offered applications are accepted for this scholarship in Spring -- to be awarded in Fall.

Award

One \$2,000 scholarship awarded annually.

Eligibility

Applicants must meet the following criteria the semester the scholarship is awarded:

- must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.0 and in good academic standing
- must be a classified graduate student in an English graduate program (Preferred interest in poetry and/or creative writing)

Please note:

- Scholarship may be renewable for up to two additional years; thus, fellowship winners may reapply in subsequent years. The student's application will be considered by the scholarship committee as part of the entire applicant pool.
- Financial need may be considered in awarding this fellowship.
