Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages Minor

Program Goals

Provide undergraduate students with an introduction to the theory and practice of teaching English to nonnative speakers.

Program of Study

The program consists of six courses (18 units) which must be taken at CSUS:

- > English 110A (Linguistics and the English Language)
- English 110P (Second Language Learning and Teaching)
- English 110Q (Grammar for ESL Teachers)
- > English 125E (Academic Reading and Writing for Second Language Students)
- English 125F (Teaching Oral Skills)
- > Elective course to be chosen from English 110 series

Notes

- 1. English majors are <u>not</u> eligible for the Minor in Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL), but they may complete the TESOL Certificate Option A.
- 2. Courses applied to other degree programs cannot apply to the TESOL minor.
