

Kenneth H. W. Earle Graduate Fellowship in History

Students are invited to apply for a fellowship of \$1,000 to support research on a project on some aspects of California history to be completed as part of a graduate program of study in the Department of History at Sacramento State. The ultimate goal of the research must be a “publishable” project, for example a completed museum exhibit, historic register nomination or a 25-30 page paper suitable for submission to an academic historic journal.

Eligible Students: Must be enrolled at least half time as a graduate student in History.

The following areas of research are encouraged:

- The Gold Rush
- Immigration and the Golden State
- The Great Depression in California
- California Railroads and Regulation
- The Automobile and Urban Growth in California
- Migratory Farm Labor in California
- Knights of Labor, the Workingman’s Party, and the Wobblies
- Water and the Environment
- Manhood and Fraternalism in California
- Women and Women’s Clubs in California

This list is not exclusive. Other research projects that explore the history and historical built environment of California are welcome.

The application must include:

- Application form
- 500-word prospectus describing the topic and its importance
- 5-10 page writing sample of previous historic research completed by the student
- Proposed plan for completion of the project

Proposals will be ranked by the following criteria:

- Creativity, originality, or innovation
- Ability to influence a wide and diverse audience
- Writing quality

The Award will be disbursed at the beginning of the Fall semester and is renewable for a second semester pending evidence of successful progress on the project.
