

## BASSOON STUDIES

The bassoon program at Sacramento State offers students the opportunity to pursue Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Music and Master of Music degrees in bassoon performance. Excellent facilities are provided for this program, in which the bassoonist may explore a variety of repertoire through participation in the Symphony Orchestra, Symphonic Wind Ensemble, Concert Band, and other chamber ensembles. Through private instruction, group rehearsal, and reed making classes, the program provides intensive study of the bassoon and contrabassoon in preparation for chamber and solo recital performances. The musically rewarding environment at Sac State will expose the bassoonist to the technical skills, musical knowledge, performance experiences and artistic standards necessary to meet the variety of musical demands encountered in the professional world today.
