Excellent facilities are provided for this diverse program in which the student may explore a wide variety of repertoire through performance with the University Orchestra, Symphonic Wind Ensemble, Concert Band, Marching Band, Jazz Ensembles and various chamber ensembles. In addition to individual instruction and specialized courses in performance practice, students also work directly with the numerous guest artists that periodically perform and teach at Sacramento State.
