ABOUT THE ARTIST

Percussionist **Jordan Shippy** is an active performer and educator that has presented in venues across the United States including Lindenwood University, Southeastern Oklahoma State University, and Arkansas Tech University. Jordan most often performs as a soloist and with his percussion chamber group, Colour Me Crimson and frequently commissions new repertoire from under-represented composers.

In addition to performing, Jordan serves as the percussion faculty at Sacramento State, conducts clinics at local high schools in the greater Sacramento area, and is a Black Swamp Percussion Educator. He holds a DMA and MM in percussion performance from the University of Oklahoma and Sacramento State, respectively.
