*** Students must have completed the equivalent of college level *intermediate Spanish* before beginning the Spanish minor. The pre-requirement may be completed by one of the following:

- in High School;
- at a Community College;
- by completing SPAN 2A/2B, SPAN 6A/6B, or SPAN 8A/8B at Sac State;
- by having a score of at least 4 in AP Spanish Language.

NOTES:

- Anticipate at least 2 years to complete the Spanish minor.
- Need to consult a faculty advisor.
- SPAN 47 is pre-requirement for all Upper-Division SPAN courses.
- SPAN 103 is a pre-requirement for SPAN 106.
- SPAN AP score of 5 = SPAN 42 and 47
- Required to get C or better in all classes toward the Minor in Spanish.
