We are excited about hosting you in this live studio event to explore how organizations can address the well-being expectations of next-generation employees, including Sacramento State students. Since pandemic, Sacramento State has made well-being a strategic priority, while also stepping forward to become an Anchor University in its region to cultivate purposeful community partnerships. Supporting these strategic actions, COB Organizational Wisdom Studio's mission is to lead an interdisciplinary platform among scholars, artists, and practitioners to co-create practical wisdom for employees, students, and larger society to enhance their health, happiness, and performance.

Today's live studio event brings together leaders from different organizations to explore how organizations can rebalance wisely towards well-being. Well-being is a multi-layered phenomenon that involves different components. During pandemic every organization navigated through challenges to promote well-being among their members. Today's event aims to take a step in this direction.

While reflecting on their recent leadership experiences, our guests will also help creating insights around "Wisdom-Oriented Leadership", where leaders feel like an intuitive scientist, think like a disruptive artist, act like an organizational engineer, and reflect like an ethical philosopher. Then we will lead an interactive forum to generate suggestions about how organizations can "renovate" their HR systems to address the next generation's well-being expectations, with prompters from the "BYOD-Bring Your Own Dream" positive imagery narratives created by Sac State students.

In addition to producing live-event projects, COB Organizational Wisdom Studio has also established a digital presence with more than 30 video-episodes published in its YouTube Channel, focusing on such topics as overcoming organizational challenges during the pandemic, regulating anger in organizations, and leading with emotional intelligence. These episodes have been viewed by more than 12,000 people across Europe, Africa, Asia, Australia, and America. A recent article in AACSB Thought Leadership Platform has featured our projects. Megan served four years as a Navy officer in Florida and Hawaii after earning a B.S. in journalism at Northwestern University in Chicago. She was the third woman in 65 years to lead the school's midshipman battalion. She was Sacramento County's Communications and Media Director, after spending 10 years in the private sector at public-relations and advertising firms in Hawaii and Florida.



Dr. Joseph VanVo is an industrial/organizational consultant since 1996, specializing in global business, organizational development (OD) & Organizational Behavior (OB). He has provided consulting services for many organizations in the United States, Asia, Australia, and Europe - both for- profit and non-profit - in education, technology, vocational nursing, residential & commercial real estate & mortgage, and consultancy. He has also been in executive

management leadership at USG Corporation (a Fortune 500) and its USG International Pacific Rim Subsidiaries - Australia, China (People's Republic of), Hong Kong, India, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Taiwan (Republic of China), Thailand, and Vietnam. In addition to teaching in College of Business at Sacramento State, he has taught in other universities both in the US and in other countries, including Australia, France, Greece, Republic of China, Thailand and Vietnam.
