- Minimum GPA to **apply** is 2.4, however, this does not guarantee admission to the program. Actual GPA cut-offs have been higher.
- GPA cutoffs for the past few semesters have been in the 2.90/3.00 range.
- All lower division requirements must be completed at the time of application.
- The number of students admitted to the major each semester will **vary** depending on faculty resources.
- Application period – for Spring semester (September 1 – October 15); for Fall semester (February 1 – March 15)
