- Create your library on your device

## Step 2:

- Set up your Endnote Cloud account <https://csus.libguides.com/EndNote/ENOnline>

## Step 3:

- Apply the fix to Endnote for APA 7<sup>th</sup> edition

  - or set up a 1:1 tutorial
